There is no one right choice. As technology progresses, even today's best choice might soon be surpassed by newer options and toys.

### **2005**

The chosen technology to communicate spatial information was **ESRI ArcReader**. To view the previous race route data, ArcReader had to be installed on the user desktop machine. This proved to be a challenge to some.

### **2007**

The data was republished in a newer format, [GeoPDF](#) which could be opened the commonly adopted Adobe Reader application.

### **2011-12**

The data moved again to keep pace with evolving technologies.
